BYLAW NO. 90-17 A BYLAW TO RESTRICT THE USE OF BULLDOZERS FOR THE REMOVAL OF SNOW ON MUNICIPAL ROADS

The council of the Rural Municipality of Excel No. 71 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- In this bylaw, "bulldozer" means any V-Type, One-Way, or Wing attached to a front or rear carrying unit.
- It shall be unlawful for any person to use a bulldozer for the removal of snow from all municipal roads.
- Section 2 of this bylaw shall not apply to any municipally owned equipment.
- 4. The provisions of section 2 hereof shall not apply to any provincial highway or bridges thereon.
- 5. Contravention of this bylaw by a snow blow club or private individual, shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality
- Bylaw No. 57-82 is hereby repealed.
