BYLAW NO. 1-2020

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF Excel NO. 71

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 20-13, known as the Zoning Bylaw.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Excel No. 71 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 20-13 as follows:

1. Section 7.5, Subdivision and Site Regulations, in the Agricultural Resource District (AR) is amended by repealing the minimum setback for trees, shelterbelts, grain bags and other from row 6 of the table and replacing it with the following:

Minimum setback for trees, shelterbelts, grain bags and other

All dugouts, shelterbelts, tree plantings, portable structures, machinery, aggregate resource stockpiles, or grain bags shall comply with the same setback requirements as for buildings.

- 2. Section 7, Agricultural Resource District (AR), is amended by adding the following directly after 7.12:
 - 7.13 Temporary Borrow Pit
 - .1 A temporary development permit may be issued for a specified period of time to accommodate a temporary borrow pit incidental to the construction of an approved development provided the following criteria and conditions are met:
 - a) The borrow pit and stockpiles shall be setback a minimum distance of 45 metres from the centreline of a developed road or provincial highway.
 - b) The borrow pit and stockpiles shall be setback a minimum distance of 7.5 metres from a site line and bank of any waterbody or watercourse.
 - c) Safety fencing and signage may be required as a condition of the development permit.
 - d) The excavation and stockpiling areas shall be re-graded and re-vegetated immediately after construction activities conclude as may be necessary to address drainage and prevent erosion.
- 3. Section 2, Definitions, is amended by adding the following definition in appropriate alphabetical order:

Borrow Pit: An excavation in the earth where soil is removed from one location to be used, without further processing, as fill at another location for construction or landscaping activities associated with an approved development.

4. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of final approval by the Minister of Government Relations.
