RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF EXCEL NO. 71

BYLAW NO. 2-2017

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 19-13 KNOWN AS THE OCP BYLAW

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Excel No. 71 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts to amend Bylaw No. 19-13 as follows:

- 1. The addition of the following:
- 4.4 Aggregate Resources (Sand and Gravel)
 - .6 The approval of a development will be based on the following:
 - i. Setback distances and other regulations in the Zoning Bylaw
 - ii. The compatibility of existing and planned land uses and the effect on the adjacent land uses.
 - iii. The impact and disturbance to the environment and groundwater
 - iv. The impact on municipal services and infrastructure
 - v. The manner in which the pit or query will be reclaimed
 - .7 Council shall require a performance bond for sand and gravel development to ensure remediation of the site.
 - .8 Applications for sand and gravel development must be accompanied by a reclamation plan including any additional information as specified in the R.M.'s Zoning Bylaw.
- 2. 8.7.1 to be amended to read as the following:

Developments will be restricted in the 1:500 flood elevation for water body or watercourse to protect against loss of life and to minimize property damage associated with flooding events. Flood prone lands will generally be limited to agriculture, park and open space recreational uses.

3. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister.
