BYLAW NO. 5-2023

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Excel No. 71, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Council" means the Council of the Rural Municipality of Excel No. 71;
 - b) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Excel No. 71; and
 - c) "Party" means either the Council or the Bylaw Enforcement Officer.
2. Council shall appoint a person(s), by resolution of council at a regularly held council meeting, as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality.
3. The appointment shall commence immediately upon appointment and shall continue at the pleasure of council.
4. The appointment may be terminated by either party providing written notice to the other party at least 30 days prior to the termination becoming effective.
5. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
 - a) To enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the council of the Municipality;
 - b) To represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw; and
 - c) Other duties as may be assigned by Council or its delegate.
6. Bylaw No. 9-2013 is hereby repealed.
7. This bylaw shall come into effect on the day of its final passing.

Read a third time and adopted this 11th day of July, 2023.


